Audition Requirements:

Pieces: Please prepare a piece of your own choice that demonstrates your abilities. RCM Grade VI or higher
G major scale – 2 octaves, Major and minor scales – up to 3 sharps and flats, one octave
Sight Reading will be required.
Orchestral Excerpts - 2 pages

- Option 1 – Both excerpts below as indicated
- Option 2 – Beethoven Symphony No. 5 - plus one other excerpt from Grade VIII RCM syllabus or above.

1) Beethoven Symphony No 5 – 1st mvt.
