Each fall, RDYO engages in a weekend-long musical retreat for our young musicians and their conductors. Orchestra Camp is an important opportunity for our musicians to bond with each other and with their conductors, as well as engaging in intensive rehearsals, sectional coaching, and master classes. Time is set aside for socializing, group games, and songs around the campfire. Our musicians make enormous musical strides during the weekend, as well as form friendship bonds that last for years.

RDYO does not charge musicians or families a fee for attending the camp, as we believe the experience is foundational to every musician's success in the Orchestra. However, as camp rentals become more expensive and as our enrollment rises, RDYO struggles to cope with the financial commitment.

A major gift of \$5000 or more would ensure that our Orchestra Camp continues to provide our young musicians with the enhanced musical instruction that they need to ensure a successful and music-filled season.

The Orchestra currently serves approximately 150 young musicians aged 8 to 25.

RDYO is operated by the BC Youth Music Society, a registered not-for-profit society (Society Number S-0009364).




